

## **RENEWABLEUK WTSR REVISIONS (January 2011)**

### **1. Changes to WTSR**

- 1.1 Rule A3.9; the word reasonably has been deleted.
- 1.2 Rule A3.11; wording changes to reflect HSE Guidance Note GS38.
- 1.3 Definition D18; typographic error corrected.
- 1.4 Definition D29; typographic error corrected.

### **2. Changes to WTSR Procedures**

- 2.1 WTSR Procedure P4; revision to Section 3.1, "PROCEDURE FOR THE ADDITION OF PLANT AND LV APPARATUS TO THE SYSTEM". Requirement added to revise SRIC if the WTSR themselves change significantly or there is a change to the contract management arrangements affecting the way in which WTSR are implemented.
- 2.2 WTSR Procedure P6; revisions to Section 5, "WITHDRAWAL OF APPOINTMENT UNDER COMPANY 'A' WTSR". Requirement added to remove any 'appointment' following an incident where there has been a suspected breach of the WTSR, pending an investigation.
- 2.3 New WTSR Support Procedure P7 introduced; "PROCEDURE FOR THE CONTROL & MANAGEMENT OF CROSS BOUNDARY SAFETY PRECAUTIONS BETWEEN THE WTSR AND THE HV SAFETY RULES". This new WTSR Support Procedure has been added to outline the cross boundary requirements between the WTSR and the Approved HV Rules.

### **3. Changes to WTSR Guidance**

- 3.1 Guidance on WTSR A3.2; revised to reinforce the requirement to contain / dissipate stored energy.
- 3.2 Guidance on WTSR B2.2.6; revised to give further guidance on interpretation.
- 3.3 Guidance on WTSR B2.4.1; addition of flowchart to give further guidance on options during 'clearance' of an AWP and in particular when exceptions are recorded.
- 3.4 Guidance on WTSR B3.3; an example pro-forma for a Routine Operating Procedure has been added.

- 3.5 Guidance on WTSR B3.4; further guidance added to confirm that the Competent Technician must inform the Operational Controller when work or testing is finished under a Routine Operating Procedure. Some guidance on the meaning of the word 'consent' has been added.
- 3.6 Guidance on WTSR B5; the following changes have been made:
- Guidance on how Company 'A' use the example pro-forma AWP has been added;
  - Guidance has been added in Addendum 2 against step 3.1 of the AWP pro-forma;
  - An example of an AWP pro-forma without a ROMP Section has been added to Addendum 2.
- 3.7 Guidance on WTSR C2.2(iv); cross references added.
- 3.8 Guidance on WTSR C2.10(i); cross reference added.
- 3.9 Guidance on WTSR C4.2; some guidance on the meaning of the word 'consent' has been added.
- 3.10 Guidance on WTSR C4.2(iv); minor wording changes to existing guidance.
- 3.11 Guidance on WTSR C4.7; further guidance added confirming the responsibility of the Competent Technician when work or testing is complete under a Routine Operating Procedure.
- 3.12 Guidance on WTSR C5.1; further guidance added to reinforce that Transfer Of Control must take place between the Authorised Technician and the Operational Controller before work starts and again when work or testing is finished under an Approved Written Procedure.
- 3.13 Guidance on WTSR C5.2; further guidance added to reinforce that 'consent' must be given to the Competent Technician by the Operational Controller before work or testing starts under a Routine Operating Procedure. When work or testing is finished the Competent Technician must inform the Operational Controller.
- 3.14 Guidance on D19(iv); some guidance on the meaning of the word 'consent' has been added.
- 3.15 All changes made to the WTSR themselves have been revised, (these changes are highlighted in Section 1 above).
- 3.16 All references to BWEA have been removed and replaced by Renewable UK.
